Grade 3

Students entering Grade 3 must read the following books:

Grade 4

Students entering Grade 4 must read the following books which must be brought to school on the first day:

- Chapter book of student's choice
- *The Castle in the Attic* by Elizabeth Winthrop

Grade 5

Students entering Grade 5 must read the following books which must be brought to school on the first day. Teachers will send an email to all incoming fifth grade parents with a link containing book report options. Please bring the novels and completed reports on the first day of school.

- *Mrs. Frisby and the Rats of NIMH* by Robert C. O'Brien
- *Holes* by Louis Sachar
